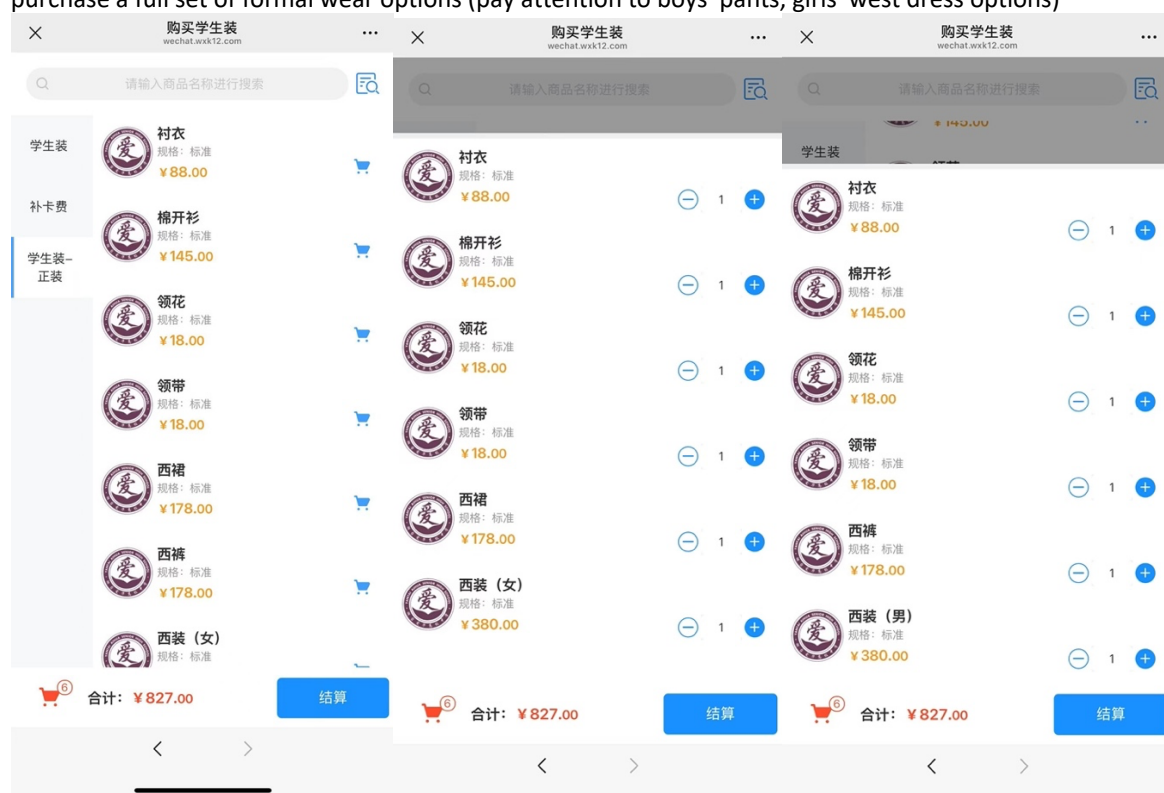
Spring Break & Staff Professional Development Day
